Bylaw No. 3-2008

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 5-97, BEING A BYLAW RESPECTING BUILDINGS.

The Council of the Town of Ituna, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw No. 5-97, being a bylaw respecting buildings, adopted on July 2, 1997, is amended as follows:
 - a) Section 5.(1) is amended by adding the following subsection:
 - a) Buildings to be constructed or moved into residential areas shall comply with the following:
 - i) Buildings shall be of wood or metal construction, sided on the exterior with metal, stucco or siding.
 - ii) Buildings may be constructed with a maximum wall height of 10 feet, of coloured metals only, shall match the buildings in the neighbourhood and shall be on a permanent foundation.
 - iii) Council may approve appropriate structures on an individual basis when a clear statement of purpose is provided.
 - iv) Final approval shall be at the discretion of Council.
