

TOWN OF ITUNA

BYLAW NO. 7-2007 A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A BASE TAX

Section 290 *The Municipalities Act*

The Council of the Town of Ituna, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Base Tax Bylaw".
2. A base tax shall apply to the types and classifications of property included in the table below:

Property Class	TYPE OF PROPERTY		Land and Improvements

a) Agriculture	\$1.00 per foot frontage		\$500.00
b) Residential	\$1.00 per foot frontage		\$500.00
c) Commercial & Industrial	\$1.00 per foot frontage		\$500.00

3. Where a property is classified within more than one property classification by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (or other evaluator), the base tax calculation shall be compared to the tax levy against the total combined assessment and shall be applied only once on each property, regardless of the number of classes of the property.
4. Bylaw No. 9-2006 is hereby repealed.
5. This bylaw shall come into effect on January 1, 2007.
